

SELECTION CRITERIA

NDIS / Aged Disability Worker

Essential:

1. Ability to relate sensitively and effectively with Indigenous people and demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the issues affecting remote communities.
2. Previous experience in successful program management, including service delivery, performance reporting, financial reporting, monitoring and evaluation.
3. Proven ability to work proactively in a team, support staff and represent Waltja.
4. Demonstrated ability to identify goals, set tasks, prioritise workloads and evaluate service outcomes with minimal supervision.
5. Demonstrated capacity for strategic decision-making and initiative to make appropriate decisions when required.
6. Prepared to undertake extensive remote travel. Current NT Drivers Licence and experience with long distance and 4WD driving.
7. Qualifications and experience in Community Work, Allied Health or related fields.

DESIRABLE CRITERIA:

1. The ability to speak or read a local Aboriginal Language
2. Familiar with local people and issues in remote Aboriginal communities in Central Australia
3. Established networks with NDIS and/or aged disability services and in Central Australia
